

1 – ESPOL'S SCHOLARSHIP

This system is intended for students or future students of ESPOL who register for Master 1 or Master 2 at ESPOL. This system can be combined with the merit's scholarship of the Catholic University of Lille Foundation and is intended to help students' finance their tuition. This scholarship can't be combined with Campus France scholarships, etc. ESPOL embraces non-discriminatory practices and equality of opportunity.

2 – Grant criteria

The excellence of the candidate, as evidenced by their previous university and/or school career (being in the first 10% of your class over the year 23-24)
The motivation of the candidate and the adequacy of his/her professional project with ESPOL training.

3 – When and how to apply

Candidates must send by e-mail a cover letter, a CV and a certificate indicating the ranking for the 2023-2024 academic year no later than July 3, 2024 at 12 a.m. CET SUMMER TIME to Grégory Scieux gregory.scieux@univ-catholille.fr.

An internal commission will meet in July under the chairmanship of a member of the ESPOL's management to select the files and award the scholarships.

4 – How much you can get and how the grants are paid

The amount of the excellence scholarship varies from €1000 to €2000.

The scholarship is awarded by transfer to the winning students after their registration in the establishment. *

* In case of withdrawal or non-validation of the academic year, the total amount of the scholarship is to be refund.
